### Instructions to the students appearing for the **I B.Tech. I Semester (2020 Admitted)** Sessional Examination-I during February 2021

#### A. General Instructions

1. All the Sessional Examinations shall be conducted for a duration of 90 Mins
2. The pattern of the Sessional Examinations shall be as follows
  - ✓ **PART- A** 3X2=6M  
(Compulsory section, One question from each Unit)
  - ✓ **PART- B-** (3X8=24M)  
(There shall be Two questions from each unit with internal choice i.e., 'either' 'or' choice.  
The student shall answer one question from each unit).

#### B. Special Instructions in view of COVID-19 Pandemic:

The "SOP issued by MoHFW, Govt of India on preventive measures in current scenario of COVID-19 will be followed by all concerned while appearing for Sessional Examinations to ensure health & safety of the students". Students are also required to adhere to guidelines and must practice **social distancing** and hygiene to ensure safety & health of their own and fellow students/faculties.

1. Every student must undergo thermal scanning at Thermal scanning stations provided in the VNRVJIET Campus for temperature check before proceeding to the Examination Halls.
2. Mandatorily usage of face mask/face shield and gloves.
3. Practice physical distancing of at least 6 feet as far as possible in the campus.
4. Students are advised to bring their own transparent water bottle to the Exam Hall
5. Students should bring their own personal small hand sanitizer and advised to use it frequently.
6. Strictly follow respiratory etiquette. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/ sneezing with a tissue/ handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
