The year 2015- 2016 was a year of achievements for CSI.

Starting with the juniors' **CSI orientation** that was successfully conducted on the **19th of August 2015**, resulted in a 170 students applying for a membership. This is one of the highest registrations that CSI has obtained. The Plan of Action was announced during the orientation, with all the tasks and events that were promised to be organized were conducted successfully.

The **Teachers Day**, conducted on the **5th of September, 2015**, was organised for the faculty of Computer Science and Engineering, The Head of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering Dr. B. Raveendra Babu, and the Director for PG, VNRVJIET Dr. C. D. Naidu presided over the meeting and enlightened the gathering about the importance of improving learning skills. Later, Ms. B.V.Kiranmayee, Assoc.prof, cut a cake followed by refreshments served for the faculty present. The students presented concluded the session by graciously thanking all the teachers for the constant and tireless efforts they put in to help them shape their future.

Techcognizance was the next event conducted on the **16th and 18th of September, 2015**. The event consisted of three rounds- group discussion, debate contest and JAM(just a minute). The main aim of the event was to improve the communication and speaking skills of the participants while researching and learning about new advancements in technology and global affairs. A total of 142 students from the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year participated in the event with only a selective few being promoted on to the next round. After the final round, 5 participants were declared as winners and awarded a price and certificate.

On the **3rd of February 2016**, a one-day hands-on experience workshop was conducted on "**EthicalHacking**". The speaker, **Mr. Ram Kumar** provided insights into the world of hacking. Around 158 students had attended the workshop conducted, with students from other branches also showing an interest to participate. Certificates of Appreciation were given to the students who actively participated in the workshop and answered all the questions posed by Mr. Ram Kumar.

Throughout the academic year, two **Know C** sessions(**31st august, 2015 and 2nd February, 2016**) were conducted. The event was conducted in the B-block seminar hall with over hundred participants. The topic of the first session was Dual Booting and the second session was The Basics of HTML and Project Loon. These sessions were a massive hit, and were requested widely to be continued in the future too.

As the academic year came to an end, the last event conducted was the Czine Magazine launch on the 16th of April, 2016. The Book was launched by Ms. S. Nagini and Ms. B. V. Kiranmayee. 57 students participated in the launch of the annual magazine. The CSI website was also launched by the chairman for the CSI Student chapter, P. Charan Singh. The best article in the magazine written by P. Venkat was chosen and explained by him to the gathering. The event came to an end as the passing out batch received tokens of appreciation for their role in managing and shaping the student chapter, CSI.
