Amir Nair's talk on the butterfly effect in management was truly inspiring. His passion for helping others achieve their potential shone through as he shared his insights on how to avoid the bridge to nowhere and never give up. He discussed the importance of being

adaptable, taking calculated risks, and avoiding distractions that lead to the "bridge to nowhere." He emphasized the importance of transformation and action and how even small changes can have a significant impact on our careers and lives. He provided practical tips for applying the butterfly effect to management, making his talk actionable.



ANVESHI JAIN

Anveshi Jain is a multifaceted personality who started her professional career as an electrical engineering graduate student. Despite facing setbacks in her life, such as failing her engineering entrance exam, Anveshi Jain persevered and decided to become a businesswoman. She started small and made her own products, eventually building her

dream shop that made it to Forbes. However, one day, her dream shop burned down, leaving her with nothing. She began creating content on YouTube and building her own app for fans. She persevered and continued to work hard, eventually becoming one of the most Googled actresses in India. Through her story, she inspires others to never give up on their dreams and to keep pushing forward, no matter how difficult things may seem. Her resilience and determination are a testament to the power of hard work and dedication. RISHABH SINGH

The speaker also emphasized the value of giving the gift of a healthy environment to our children and urged individuals to take actions such as planting trees to help achieve this.

ADITI SHARMA

Aditi Sharma, Mrs Universe India 2022, and Mrs Photogenic 2022 also shared their views on the theme. She spoke of her childhood and the steps she has taken to ensure the little changes in her life. From a young age, her dream to represent India at an international level kept her spirits high.
