MINUTES:

(1) B.Tech Course Structure and Syllabus for the Academic year 2013-14.

- (i) The members suggested to have uniform course structure against all the departments. After elaborate discussion, members agreed that yearwise, total number of credits were normalized for uniformity across the departments.
- (ii) The Committee members expressed that the elective courses may be started in 3rd year B.Tech. The number of subjects offered in each of the electives is to be limited to five. Out of the elective courses offered, one can be open elective.
- (iii) The mode of evaluation of the internal examination (i.e., 80% of the best internal and 20% of the other internal) which is in force is to be continued.

However, the decimal of total marks obtained may be rounded to the next highest value while calculating 80% and 20% weightage of internal marks.

- (iv) Same nomenclature and credits should be adopted to the title / topics common between the departments. Eg:- Industry oriented mini project, project work, comprehensive viva etc.

(2) M.Tech Course Structure and Syllabus for the Academic year 2013-14.

- (i) Members suggested giving equal weightage for Mid-Term Examinations. The Mid term performance in a Semester of the student is evaluated as average of the two Mid term examination marks.

(3) Academic Regulations for B.Tech and M.Tech.

- (i) It is resolved to approve the exemption upto two subjects not exceeding a maximum of 8 Credits to obtain B.Tech Degree. The student has to register for all the 200 credits.
- (ii) The malpractice Committee should have Principal as the Chairman, Controller of Examinations (CoE) as Convenor, Invigilator in the respective room(s), Subject expert and concerned Heads of the Department as members.
- (iii) Ensure faculty involvement / participation for the shadow engineering, project work and other initiatives of the institute.
- (iv) It is resolved that memorandum of marks issued to the student may have the CGPA along with total marks obtained in the Academic year / Semester.

- (4) The Chairman of the Academic Council informed the members that Vignana Jyothi is applying for the Deemed to be University status in due course.

The meeting concluded with the members wishing good luck for the Deemed University Status and thanks to the Chair.
