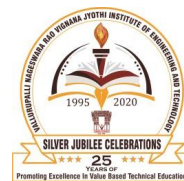

### **Measures Taken to curb Ragging in the campus for the A.Y.2021-22**

- 1) The regulations of UGC on curbing the menace of ragging in higher education institutions have been uploaded on VNRVJ1ET website for information to all VNRVJ1ET students, parents/guardians.
- 2) VNRVJ1ET Anti-Ragging committee has been constituted, consisting of senior students, parents, staff, faculty and counselors and is put up in the Institute website along with telephone numbers of members of the Committee.
- 3) Anti-Ragging posters with extracts of UGC Regulations on acts which constitute Ragging, abetment of Ragging, Penalties which can be imposed and help-line numbers has been displayed / exhibited and notified to all the students on the campus.
- 4) A detailed undertaking regarding Anti-Ragging has been obtained from students and their parents /guardians and the same has been kept on our record.
- 5) Dr. M. Sreedhar, Chairman, Anti-Ragging Committee, Dr. C.D.Naidu, Principal, VNR VJ1ET addressed the junior and senior students about the menace of ragging and the need to curb it and suggested various measures to prevent it.
- 6) 200 numbers CC cameras have been installed in the campus to closely monitor the activities and incidence of ragging if any.
- 7) All the first year students are placed in a separate Boys & Girls Hostels and they been monitored closely by the wardens and anti-ragging committee.
- 8) A group of faculty, staff and senior students are identified and assigned the work of going around different blocks in the campus to see that no incident of Ragging happen.
