The following is the summary of the activities of the IQAC of VNRVJiet


1. The annual Quality Assurance Report for the Academic Year 2016-17 was submitted on 29th August 2017.
2. The IQAC organized seminars on
 - a) “Quality metrics in Higher” by Dr. MG Sethuraman, Prof. in Dept. of Chemistry, Gandhigram Rural Institute.
 - b) POGIL methodologies for Teaching-Learning Processes.
3. The IQAC also organized a One-day workshop on “The Use of Moodle” for the benefit of the Faculty.
4. The IQAC has been instrumental in organizing High Intensity Training Program for students for preparing them for placements.
5. In order to promote research among the faculty, the IQAC not only conducted sensitization programs on Research Culture but also conducted a workshop on Writing Project Proposals.
6. The IQAC initiated the analysis of Journal Publications, Faculty Qualification Enhancement and NIRF data.
7. The initiative of the IQAC to help the faculty enhance their qualifications and teaching methodologies extended to the promotion of NPTEL courses and FDP programs in ICT through IIT Bombay and promotion of MHRD’s National Mission for Education program through ICT.
8. The IQAC developed Quality indices for infrastructure in the Institute such as Classrooms, Laboratories, Seminars Halls, Auditorium and Hostels.

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9. Faculty Development Programs initiated by IQAC have taken the form of a seminar on Flipped Classroom and Blended Learning which focus on active learning, an interactive session on POGIL, a training session on Blooms Taxonomy, and a Guest lecture on 'Understanding Global Education framework and Technology in Education, a session on Moocs, and a Lecture on WIT and WIL, a novel teaching methodology.
10. The Institute also established a Centre for Education Technology and an Experiential Learning Centre.

Recommendations made by IQAC

1. It is suggested that we need to create an eco-friendly environment in the Institute.
2. The Institute needs to give more emphasis on improving consultancy work.
