"A Report on the Guest Lecture "Writing a Synopsis" held on 7-11-2018"

The Department of Humanities and Sciences organised a Guest Lecture on "Writing a Synopsis" on the 7th of November, 2018. The speaker was Professor Veda Sharan from EFLU, Dept. of English Language Education. The target audience for the Guest Lecture was Faculty pursuing Ph.D. and M.Tech. Students. The Lecture was scheduled for the afternoon session therefore it began at 2.00 p.m.

Professor Veda Sharan began his Lecture with a talk on the importance of vocabulary. He emphasized on the need to understand collocations and the use of contextually appropriate words. He informed the audience that Oxford-3000 Dictionary can be very helpful in increasing one's repertoire of vocabulary.

Later, Professor Veda Sharan explained the audience on how to write an Abstract/Synopsis through a Power Point Presentation. He made clear the differences between an abstract, a synopsis, and an executive Summary. He said that although an Abstract and Synopsis can be considered to be synonymous, an abstract is more concise. He said that one should aim at brevity when writing an abstract.

The Lecture was followed by a Question/ answer session and concluded at 4.00 p.m. Thirty two Faculty members and 135 M. Tech. students from all Disciplines attended the Guest Lecture. The participants appreciated the Lecture and said that it was very useful to them.
